## **The Good Shepherd**

## Text: John 10:11-21

<u>Main Idea</u>: The Good Shepherd sacrifices, loves & leads His Sheep & they hear His voice & follow Him!

- 1. The Good Shepherd \_\_\_\_\_\_ for His sheep. (v. 11-13, 17b-18)
  - *Voluntary*: Jesus willingly gave up His \_\_\_\_\_, his whole person for the sheep.
  - *Substitution*: Jesus died \_\_\_\_\_\_ or "on behalf of" or as a substitutionary atonement for His sheep. (2 Cor 5:21, 1 Pet 2:24, 3:18)
  - *Propitiation*: Jesus actually paid the actual debt with his life as a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to the wrath of God. (Rom 3:25, 1 John 2:2, 4:10)
- 2. The Good Shepherd \_\_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ for His sheep. (v. 12-15)

  - *Intimate*: He has intimate \_\_\_\_\_\_ of his sheep perfectly. (14b-15a)
