Application Questions:

- 1. To you as a 21st century believer, the argument of Hebrews 7 may seem insignificant. Put yourself in the position of a 1st century Jew who has abandoned his upbringing of Judaism and all the Old Covenant rituals including the system of the Levitical Priesthood in order to follow Jesus. What argument is the author of Hebrews using to persuade these Jews that Jesus is our great High Priest?
- 2. What is typology? Think of a few examples in the OT that pointed to Christ in the NT (See Numbers 21:6-9 & John 3:14; Lev 22:19-21 & 1 Peter 1:18-19). In what ways was Melchizedek a type of Christ? List five characteristics that the author identifies.
- 3. Why is it significant that Melchizedek is superior to Abraham? (See John 8:53-59) What 2 examples does the author use to make his argument? Why is it important that the whole line of the Levitical priests actually be in the loins of Abraham? What does this say about the nature of Melchizedek's priesthood compared to the Levitical Priesthood?
- 4. Some believe that Melchizedek was a pre-incarnate Christ. What wording in verse 3b disputes this idea? What is the significance of the obscure description of Melchizedek's origin in v. 3? Is the author speaking directly about the man's birth & death, or is he directly contrasting the nature of Melchizedek's priesthood with that of the Levitical Priesthood? (See Numbers 8:23-26)
- 5. Why is it important for us that Jesus be our High Priest in the line of Melchizedek rather than the line of the Levitical Priesthood? What makes the priesthood of Jesus superior to the Levitical priesthood? Read ahead to Hebrews 7:18-19, 24-25. What important role does Jesus provide that no other priest has ever or ever could provide?

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
