Scripture is God-breathed	
 For the word of God is (Hebrews 4:12) For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. (II Peter 1:20-21) 	
Scripture prepares the man of God to be thoroughly equipped for every good work. (3:16-17)
