The Triumph of Christ's Suffering

Text: 1 Peter 3:18-22

Main Idea: Victory is sure for believers because Christ has triumphed over sin, evil powers and is exalted!

- 1. *Triumph over* _____: Christ suffered by bearing our sin! (v. 18a)
 - <u>What</u>: Christ suffered death for sins ______ for all. (Isaiah 53:1-11, Heb 9:25-28)
 - <u>For Whom</u>: Christ suffered as the ______ for the unrighteous. (2 Cor 5:21)
 - <u>Why</u>: Christ suffered in order to ______ us to God.
- 2. **Triumph over** ______: By the power of the Holy Spirit, Christ was raised from the dead and proclaimed victory over demonic spirits. (v. 18b-20b, 2 Peter 2:4-5, Jude 6-7, Col 2:14-15)
- 3. *Triumph for* ______: Christ saves through the immersion of His resurrection symbolized in baptism just like Noah was saved by faith. (v. 20c-21)
- 4. *Triumph into* ______: Finally, Christ is now exalted on high as the resurrected and ascended Lord and has subjected *all* powers to himself. (v. 22)
