

Summer in the Psalms Psalm 130 From the Depths to the Heights

130:1 A song of ascents

Most interpreters think these psalms (120-134) were sung by Jewish pilgrims as they made their way up to _____ and to the temple mount for the three festivals - Passover, Pentecost and the Day of Atonement.

If you read through these Songs of Ascent, you will notice the two key parts of true worship:

• To see _____ as he really is

• To see ______ as we really are

Out of the depths I cry to you, O LORD;

In Hebrew thought being in "the depths" refers to either being caught in dangerous or deep waters which threaten to drown you or in a deep pit that seems hopeless from which to escape.

Psalm 69:2 (drowning in the floods of trouble) I sink in the miry _____, where there is no foothold...

Psalm 71:20 (sunk down into a deep pit) you will restore my life again; from the _____ of the earth you will again bring me up.

But here in Psalm 130, it is the depths of _____ and the writer feels so deeply. He's in a hole he made himself, a pit of sin.
