

# Until He Comes

## (Part 2 – Faithfully Serving!)

**Text:** Matthew 25:14-30

**Main Idea:** Faithful servants who use their gifts to make gains for their master while He is away will be blessed, while wicked servants will be condemned.

1. As servants of the Lord, every human being is \_\_\_\_\_  
& responsible to use gifts to make gains for our Lord (not ourselves), & for His glory!
  
2. \_\_\_\_\_, both spiritual (to believers) & common grace gifts (to both believers & unbelievers) are given according to one's capacity by the sovereign God. (1 Cor 12:11, 1 Peter 4:10-11)
  
3. When the Lord comes again, there will be a reckoning - a time of \_\_\_\_\_ where He expects the servant's labor to have made an increase. (John 5:22, 2 Cor 5:10)
  
4. Rewards are given by God according to \_\_\_\_\_,  
not according to the magnificence of the gift.
  
5. The eternal \_\_\_\_\_ are going to be **magnificent**  
for the faithful & **devastating** for the wicked!
  - For the *faithful*: More responsibility, blessings, & eternal \_\_\_\_\_ in heaven! (Ps 16:11)
  - For the *wicked*: Emptiness & eternal \_\_\_\_\_.
