

# Congregational Budget Meeting December 12, 2010

### Prayer:

Pastor Dick Bickings opened the meeting in prayer.

### Roll Call:

### **Elections:**

- <u>Elders:</u> Mike Capaldi & Andy Brimer were presented for re-election to the Board of Elders by congregational vote using a secret ballot. Both Mike and Andy were approved as Elders for three-year terms.
- <u>Deacons</u>: Bruce Eckel was presented for re-election to the Board of Deacons and Kamba Kalubi was presented as a new nominee to the Board of Deacons. Both were approved by the congregation via secret ballot.

### Presentation of 2011 Budget:

Dick Albright, Interim Treasurer, presented the 2011 Budget to the congregation. Below are some highlights from the presentation which was distributed prior to the meeting (Attachment #1)

- Dick explained the basic definition of a budget which is a forecast of anticipated income and expenses. Ideally, the expenses should be in-line with the income (giving).
- The Elders do not want to use our savings to cover expenses, rather that we will manage expenses prudently.
- The budget process is not a "use it or lose it" philosophy. Any funds not utilized can be saved for future needs.
- In 2010, our income was 90% of the budgeted or forecasted income. Fortunately, the expenses for 2010 were 88% of the budgeted amount. This was in big part due to not paying a Senior Pastor and the prudence exercised by the staff and ministry leaders.
- As a result of the 2010 financial situation, the guidance given for the 2011 budget was to reduce income and expenses by 10% in comparison to 2010.

- The process for building the budget was as follows:
  - 1. Treasurer establishes the process and creates the workbooks with data and reports included.
  - 2. The Finance Committee meets to recommend the general guidance for the budget.
  - 3. The ministry leaders and staff build and populate the budget worksheets and submit them to the Treasurer for consolidation.
  - 4. The Board of Elders reviews the budget as a whole and makes adjustments if necessary. They then vote to approve the budget to be submitted for Congregational vote.
- This year, prior to the Elder review (step 4) the budgeted expenses exceeded the budgeted income by a substantial amount. The options for balancing the budget included reductions in staff, lowering healthcare expenses for the staff or further reductions in ministry expenses. During the meeting, the elders reviewed the submitted budgets from a different perspective than in years past. Since the staff and ministry leaders had already been exercising prudence in 2010, the elders used this year as the basis for a zero-based budgeting exercise. By doing so, we were able to take a realistic view of current expenditures and adjust the budget accordingly. This allowed the elders to protect critical budgets like compensation and missions while decreasing in areas where the budgeted resources are not being fully used now. Of course, difficult tradeoffs had to be made along the way.
- Dick reviewed the budget in detail using a PowerPoint presentation (Attachment #1).
- Questions From the Floor:
  - 1) Several questions and comments were raised regarding the Prime Timers ministry budget.
  - 2) Rick Davis made clarifying comments before entertaining further questions.
  - Additional questions were asked regarding the Building Fund, Pastoral Intern, Ebenezer Loving Ministry and Utilities. All questions were answered by the requisite elder or ministry leader.
- Motion was made to approve the budget and was seconded. A request was made to vote by secret ballot and was granted.
- The 2011 budget was passed by a vote of 56 yes, 20 no and 3 abstentions.
- An additional question came from the floor regarding the Senior Pastor search process. Rick
  Davis told the congregation that a candidate had been presented to the Elders by the search
  committee, was interviewed by the Elders and had been submitted to the Ministerial
  Credentials Committee for consideration by the denomination since he is outside of the BFC.

Meeting was adjourned.
