## Nursery Ministry Health Policy

- Children with contagious conditions are not permitted in nursery care. These include but are not limited to measles, chicken pox, strep throat, bronchitis, fever, pink eye, or head lice.
- Children with obvious symptoms of illness such as nasal discharge, severe cough, diarrhea, or vomiting should remain at home until symptoms have completely resolved.
- Since young children often share toys and teething implements, any nursery-age child testing positive for HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis, or Tuberculosis are to remain with their parents. This provides protection for the infected child who is susceptible to infections as well as other children within the church.
- This policy has been devised to protect the health of our children. This policy is not intended to discriminate nor make it difficult for parents to attend church services.
- Nursery workers reserve the right to not accept your child that day due to any of the above reasons. We ask that you abide by this policy so this will not happen.
