## **VOMIT PROCEDURES:**

- 1. Use vinyl gloves, trash bag(s), #64 disinfectant spray (used only on hard surfaces), and paper towels located in the cleaning closet by the BCS office & across from bathrooms.
- 2. Use "Odor Sorb" absorption granules from the closet.
- 3. Cover soiled area with layer of material. Allow a few minutes for thorough absorption. You may need extra if it appears to still be liquidy.
- 4. Use a dust pan and dust brush to pick up the majority of spill and place it in a trash bag. Tie up the bag when finished.
- 5. Use Oreck XL vacuum located in the cleaning closet by the bathrooms by room #5. It will be marked "Bodily Fluids Only" on the handle. Vacuum all areas where absorbent material was used.
- 6. Use the little Bissel carpet cleaner from the top shelf in the closet by the BCS office. Check solution tank. If additional solution is needed, open the yellow cabinet and find the Bissel solution. Turn machine on and clean all areas where the absorbent was.

## When finished, please do the following:

- 7. Take the bag out of the vacuum cleaner, place it in a trash bag, and tie the bag.
- **8.** Take 2 trash bags from the vomit and vacuum cleaner bag along with the vinyl gloves that were used and place them in a large trash bag and tie it up. Take trash bag outside to the dumpster immediately. **Do NOT place large trash bag in the cleaning closet.**
- 9. Rinse off the Bissel brush head, vacuum cleaner head, dust plan, and dust brush with #64 disinfectant cleaner from the dispenser machine located in the cleaning closet by the BCS office.
- 10. Leave items in the slop sink to air dry.
